## **Psalm 127:1-2**

<sup>1</sup> Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchman waketh *but* in vain.

<sup>2</sup> *It is* vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: *for* so he giveth his beloved sleep.

## **Psalm 128:1**

<sup>1</sup> Blessed *is* every one that feareth the LORD; that walketh in his ways.

## **Ephesians 6:1-3**

<sup>1</sup> Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.

<sup>2</sup> Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;)

<sup>3</sup> That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

## **Ephesians 6:4**

<sup>4</sup> And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

## **Galatians 6:7-8**

<sup>7</sup> Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

<sup>8</sup> For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

## **Isaiah 1:18-20**

<sup>18</sup> Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

<sup>19</sup> If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land:

<sup>20</sup> But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken *it*.

## **Isaiah 59:1-4**

<sup>1</sup> Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:

<sup>2</sup> But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid *his* face from you, that he will not hear.

<sup>3</sup> For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness.

<sup>4</sup> None calleth for justice, nor *any* pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity.

## **1 John 3:1-3**

<sup>1</sup> Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

<sup>2</sup> Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know

that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

<sup>3</sup> And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

### **2 Corinthians 3:17**

<sup>17</sup> Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord *is*, there *is* liberty.

### **Psalm 25:1-5**

<sup>1</sup> Unto thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul.

<sup>2</sup> O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me.

<sup>3</sup> Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.

<sup>4</sup> Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.

<sup>5</sup> Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou *art* the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.

### **Psalm 27:7-11**

<sup>7</sup> Hear, O LORD, *when* I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me.

<sup>8</sup> *When thou saidst*, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy face, LORD, will I seek.

<sup>9</sup> Hide not thy face *far* from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

<sup>10</sup> When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.

<sup>11</sup> Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.

### **Psalm 86:11**

<sup>11</sup> Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name.

### **Psalm 119:9-12**

<sup>9</sup> Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed *thereto* according to thy word.

<sup>10</sup> With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments.

<sup>11</sup> Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

<sup>12</sup> Blessed *art* thou, O LORD: teach me thy statutes.

### **Acts 4:12**

<sup>12</sup> Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

### **Romans 3:10**

<sup>10</sup> As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

### **Romans 3:23**

<sup>23</sup> For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

### **Romans 6:23**

<sup>23</sup> For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

### **Romans 3:24**

<sup>24</sup> Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

**Ephesians 4:21-24**

<sup>21</sup> If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:

<sup>22</sup> That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

<sup>23</sup> And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

<sup>24</sup> And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

**Philippians 1:9-11**

<sup>9</sup> And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and *in* all judgment;

<sup>10</sup> That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;

<sup>11</sup> Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.
