Dear Pastor and Friends,

December, 2011

I hope that everyone is doing fine. First of all, may the Lord bless you for your faithful prayers and financial support. It is a blessing to fight for the name of the Lord. The Lord is doing a wonderful work here in Togo. It is good to report that lost souls are saved and the church is growing. The average of the adult church is now 90-100 (women 53, men 47) and the average of children's church is 96-105. On November 27, I baptized 18 people with the help of Pastor McMillen. Pastor McMillen, my former pastor came to help me do the baptism service. The fourth of my father's wives was among these people. All her family was there to watch her give her testimony about her salvation. It was a blessing especially for me to see one my father's wives came to know the Lord through my ministry and to baptize her in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost. Brothers and Sisters, the Lord is working although we faced many challenges. Since we came back, we looked everywhere to buy land for the church but we could not because the price was so high. The price of the land became number one issue in our country. The Government was unable to change the situation. The price had reached \$38,000 for two lots in the area we are working. Friends, in this troubled moment when I did not know what to do, our church landlord, a Christian man came to me and said "Brother Vincent, I saw the work the Lord is doing here. I want to sell my property to the church at \$23,555". So amazing, I could not believe it! The Lord is so good. Today, we bought the property and we are not going to move anywhere. Our next step is to build the church.

- The Church at Korbongou in the northern part our country is doing very well. The average is: adult 30 children 45. We have a lot of Muslim children. The worship place is the big problem we have. By the Grace of Almighty God, the Atwood Baptist Church in Alabama gave \$9,000 to build the church for them. Soon they will have their own place.
- I have a big issue with the church at Daliko because the brother I put there before leaveing for the States had changed the church to a charismatic church. Keep praying for me. The devil wants to destroy my ministries because I preached and people are saved in the areas where no Baptist preacher wanted to go. I went to the place where no one wanted to go in order to bring the light to the people in darkness. Now, the devil and some Christian people want to destroy our ministries. They failed because Our Lord is the winner.
- Brothers and sisters I still need your help to pay back our mission board for the shipping cost and the customs fees in Togo (\$8,050).
- Pray for Dr. Steve, he will be in Togo in February for mission conference. May the Lord bless all.
