

Dear Pastor and Friends,

Brothers and sisters, I am very thankful to God for each of you for faithful prayers and financial support. With your faithful prayers, we keep doing what God called us for. Both ministries we have here in Togo are doing fine. The Lord continues to bless our ministries in spite many challenges we are facing. The average of our attendance every Sunday is between 220-230 (Women 58, men 48, children 120). A lot of people just want to hear a Prosperity Gospel. We have these past two months many visitors in our church but a lot did not want to stay because I do not play a drum or let people dance. They said also I am too straight on the Bible. I believe we are in the last time and we have to preach the truth and not let the people play with God. The Lord Himself said to the Samaritan women in John 4:23-24, "But the hour cometh and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him." We have no right to give unto the people what they want to hear but to preach the truth to them. The month of July, God blessed our youth camp organized on July 22-28 with 300 youth enrolled. We have seen the Hand of God on that meeting because many made a profession of faith. This youth camp 2012 was a big success because God is in control.

The temple of Atwood Baptist Church we are building at Korbongou and the work is going very well. See pictures of the progress of the work on the next page. When the building is done, I believe that will open the door for many people in that area.

While I was so busy with the youth camp and the work construction at Korbongou, I put in place the plan of the future building of our home church at Apedoke. This building can hold 500 members. Here is a picture. Keep praying for that project.
