

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Agbodo family greets you from Togo in the Lord's precious Name. We are really glad to update you on our ministry here in Togo (West Africa). We give thanks to the Lord for those who pray for us and do not forget those who continue to give us their financial support in this financial crisis. May our heavenly Father reward them! It is a pleasure for us to give the summary of our ministries.

Good News

Our ministry is moving forward, the adolescent class was opened, and the attendance of Sunday evening worship was beyond our expectation. We have almost ¾ of our people. We have more women, 55 to 65 every Sunday. We used Sunday evening to teach the different subjects as Seminary course, and it is working. More people from other churches are coming to hear these teachings.



The second church at Korbongou is growing also with 67 in attendance (including children) every Sunday. This is a great blessing because it is a Muslim area.

-By the grace of God this year we are able to buy the school supplies for only 75 children. We had planned to reach 200 children but we do not have enough money.

-If God will, we will baptism 16 people our next baptism service include my mother.

Family Matters

Our family is doing fine. Samuel and Lydia are going back to home school program. Their school fees are so expensive for our budget (\$1,775). For one kid, you pay \$1,395. Because of this cost we are not able to put Emmanuel on the program this year. Emmanuel started French school this year. We need your help to put all our children in homeschool, which it is a good program for them. Samuel is working hard to play piano and Lydia is doing very well in singing.



Bad News

Right now, we have three new mission fields opened: One in Volta Region, Ghana, one in Cotonou, Benin, and one in suburb of Lome (Togo). Men are being trained to do these works but there's no money to support them. It is very painful for me to see it. God opens the doors but no money to do it. We have two churches and 5 co-workers with 15 children to feed. It is not easy to do the ministry without enough support. I believe with 4 or 5 more supporting churches we can start at least one church in 2013. Keep praying for us.

Ministry Needs:

- Need two motorbikes for the ministry here (\$2,000 for all). Brothers and sisters, I came again to you asking about your help. I just need four churches with \$500 each one to supply this need. These motorbikes would help us to take the Gospel into remote villages in Togo. I see many people gave their lives to the Lord in their remote villages. People are hungry to hear the truth in their remote villages, to get the devil out of hand. Help us please.
- We need a guest speaker for our next Bible Conference 2013. We would like to have a pastor from the States to preach and teach for three days. The pastor will pay for his own air tickets and help us with the cost of the conference of \$1,500. Last year we had more than 100 national pastors in the Bible Conference.
- Pray that God gives us wisdom to develop His ministry here in Togo.

Brothers and sisters, we do appreciate the time you put aside to read our newsletters and pray for us. Your financial support is highly valued. We have never been able enough to express our gratitude.
