The months of April to June were not easy for us. Our churches in North of Togo and Burkina must face many challenges to help these people that are fleeing the terrorists' attacks by providing them with a little assistance as foods and schooling of these children. We do not have enough support to face these challenges, but we believe with the help of brothers and sisters we will do our part not only to provide physical needs but also spiritual needs. Insecurity in Burkina Faso makes people afraid to go and cultivate their fields. People are so hungry and eat the leaves of the trees.



We were dealing with this challenge when I lost one of my faithful lady members of age74, one my uncle and one uncle of my wife. It was a difficult time but the grace of God we went through with His Help. If you can help in that matter that would be a big help to us.



Our brothers in Burkina Faso are building two classrooms to help these refugee people to have a school for their children.

Little by little we built a toilet, and we are working to build a storage at Kleme church (Togo) where we can stock the chairs against the stealing. If you can help us to finish that storage that would be a big help. We just need around \$700. The church of Kleme is growing and we need to have these items in place.



In Burkina Faso, the new work that was started in Bagrouatenga is going well. To have a shelter for them for worship service we started to make a sound block to build that shelter. We praise God because we are seeing souls saved month by month through our missions churches.



We are still looking for \$1,440 to pay (tuition fees, books, transport, and foods) for three of our preacher boys to finish their last school year of training.

Keep praying that the Lord would provide the fund of \$50,000 (received so far \$8,000) that we need to buy that propriety. We need a miracle.
