Dear Pastor, church family, and praying Friends,

Brothers and sisters, our Lord is always faithful and has continuously been blessing us in spite many terrorists attack we are facing in Burkina Faso and North of Togo.

From January 2024 to March, we have seen the hand God in salvation. God still saved people in this terrible situation with the fear we are living in.

In North of Togo, seventy-eight (78) souls (29 adults and 49 children) were saved in village of Tagbamote 7 km of Korbongou where we went to present the Gospel. On average 23 people come to the church at Korbongou. No bus ministry, they must walk or take motorbike taxi. Even though this village is open for the gospel we cannot open a new church because of lack of funds.



In Burkina Faso, The Lord is using our brothers to reach many people in spite the general fear of attack of Terrorists. Thirty-eight (38) precious souls were saved and nineteen (19) will be baptized on Easter Day.



Our brothers in Burkina Faso are fighting to help schooling children displaced by war. 6149 schools were closed from December 2021 to May 2023 in Burkina Faso according to the Government. The fear is everywhere because Terrorists can conduct attacks anywhere now with little or no warning. To be honest the situation is not good.
